

2020 Goaltender Evaluations

For the 2020 season, Glenlake will use independent evaluators for the goaltender evaluations. The following format will be used during the evaluations:

Goalie Only Sessions:

- There will be two (2) "Goalie Only" evaluation ice sessions per age group including U11 Hybrid.
- During these sessions, all goalies WILL BE EVALUATED while performing a number of drills to demonstrate their skill level. The drills and the criteria being used to evaluate the goalies will be posted on the Glenlake website in the evaluation section.
- Ranking Based on the outcome of the skills and Full Squad/Player Skills
 evaluations together with other factors, the goalies will be ranked and assigned
 to scrimmage session groups most suited to their abilities. The top ranked
 goalies will be assigned to the scrimmages for the top player group.

• Full Squad/Player Skill Sessions:

- U11 Full Time, U13, U15, and U18 goalies will take part in all Player Skills
 Sessions (except the timed skate) as goaltenders. They WILL BE EVALUATED during these sessions.
- U11 Hybrid Goalies will take part in all player sessions as players, including the timed drills. They WILL BE EVALUATED AS PLAYERS DURING THESE SESSIONS

• Scrimmage sessions:

 Once we get to this part of the evaluation process, the cohorts will be established, and goalies will have been placed according to their performance in the Goalie Only and Player Skills Sessions. GOALIES WILL NOT BE EVALUATED FURTHER DURING THE SCRIMMAGE SESSIONS.

• Extra Information:

- During the skills sessions, goalies will be evaluated on their practice play, movement, positioning and recovery. An example of the criteria used to evaluate the goalies will be posted on the Glenlake website in the evaluation section.
- After each skills session, the ranking of the goalies will be reviewed and adjusted if required.
- Goalies may MOVE UP OR DOWN from skills session to skills session. These
 moves are not necessarily indicative of ranking, but may reflect the desire of the
 evaluators to see how the goalies perform against different shooters or among a
 different group of goaltenders.



- Report Card All goalies will receive a report card after the evaluations have been completed.
- Goaltender Team Selection In general, the final selection of goaltenders and assigning goalies to a team will depend on the number of Goalies available to be placed on each cohort. Goalies will be ranked and distributed through the cohorts as outlined in the Hockey Calgary Return To Play guidelines.
- Final Goaltender Rankings will be determined after the final skills session and will reflect a combination of performance evaluation in the Goalie Only Sessions, Player Skills Sessions, the division of team on which the goaltender played the previous season, and the player assessment of that goaltender by his/her coaches from the previous season. The ranking for the Goaltenders will be calculated using a weighted average with the following weightings:

2 Goalie Only Sessions and 3 Player Skills Sessions

Session	Weighting
Goalie Only 1	26%
Goalie Only 2	26%
Skills 1	16%
Skills 2	16%
Skills 3	16%
