



2021 Goaltender Evaluations

For the 2021 evaluation season, Glenlake will use independent evaluators for the goaltender evaluations. The following format will be used during the evaluations:

- **Goalie Only Sessions:**
 - There will be two (2) "Goalie Only" evaluation ice sessions for U11 (Including Hybrids), U13, U15, and U18.
 - During these sessions, all goalies WILL BE EVALUATED while performing a number of drills to demonstrate their skill level.

- **Scrimmage Sessions**
 - U11 Full Time, U13, U15, and U18 goalies will take part in all scrimmage sessions as goaltenders. They WILL BE EVALUATED during these sessions.
 - U11 Hybrid Goalies will take part in some scrimmages as players, and some as goalies. The sessions will be decided on based on their performance in the first goalie only tech skate.

- **Ranking**
 - Based on the outcome of the "Goalie Only" and "Scrimmage" sessions, the goalies will be ranked and assigned to teams most suited to their abilities.

- **Extra Information:**
 - During the scrimmages goalies will be evaluated on their game play, movement, positioning, recovery, and mental stamina.
 - After each scrimmage, the ranking of the goalies will be reviewed and adjusted if required.
 - Goalies may MOVE UP OR DOWN from skills session to skills session. These moves are not necessarily indicative of ranking, but may reflect the desire of the evaluators to see how the goalies perform against different shooters or among a different group of goaltenders.
 - Goalies DO NOT take part in the Player Skills sessions or the timed drills (unless you are in the U11 Hybrid Program. Please refer to that document for further information)

- **Goaltender Team Selection** - In general, the final selection of goaltenders and assigning goalies to a team will depend on the number of Goalies available to be placed on each team. Goalies will be ranked and distributed as per Hockey Calgary guidelines.



- **Final Goaltender Rankings** - will be determined after the final scrimmage or goalie only session (depending on which is the last evaluation time for your age group) and will reflect a combination of performance evaluation in the Goalie Only Sessions and Scrimmages. Should there be further criteria needed, Glenlake reserves the right to use the player assessment of that goaltender by his/her coaches from the previous season to finalize team rankings. The ranking for the Goaltenders will be calculated using a weighted average with the following weightings:
 - 2 Goalie Only Sessions and 4 Scrimmage Sessions (U11 Hybrid Goalies may only get 2 scrimmage sessions depending on player rankings. In that case, each scrimmage will count for 30% of their final score).

Session	Weighting
Goalie Only 1	20%
Goalie Only 2	20%
Scrimmage 1	15%
Scrimmage 2	15%
Scrimmage 3	15%
Scrimmage 4	15%
Total	100%
