

WEST CALGARY HOUSE LEAGUE Volunteer Roles

Coordinates and manages all aspects of WCHL while working with Administrators from Glenlake, Springbank and Trails West and Hockey Calgary as required to execute program effectively
Works closely with WCHL Coordinator;
Responsible for managing all communication concerning health $\&$ safety during the season (i.e. COVID)
 work with WCHL Coordinator to determine coaches for all teams provide drills for pre-skate/evaluation skates provide weekly practice plans to Head Coaches provide support as needed to Head Coaches
Assist with distributing WCHL team equipment after teams formed & with collecting equipment after season ends
Responsible for collecting volunteer bond cheques at first evaluation skate and reconciling the cheques the age division registration list
Check in players for scheduled pre-skates
Lead on ice portion of pre skates (practice plans provided) - Skates and helmet required
Check in players for scheduled evaluation skates
Responsible for distributing, collecting (includes washing and folding) evaluation pinnies
Lead on ice portion of evaluations (evaluation skills & drills provided) - Skates and helmet required
Evaluates the players for a specific age category as directed by the Evaluation committee - 1 or 2 credits depending on the number of sessions required for the age category
Assist coaches in preparing game sheet, organising timekeepers, and other duties.
Responsible for development of practice plans and attending any necessary coach meetings/sessions - Only 1 head coach per team
Assistant coaches work with the head coach on development/execution of practice plans etc Maximum of 4 assistant coaches per team
Oversee the WCHL festival, ensure coordination of timekeepers, scorekeepers, etc. for the age division and works closely with other age division Festival coordinator to ensure continuity of event
As needed by the program, may include last minute timing
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
