

Coach – Viewing Qualifications/CRC on HCR 3.0 Spordle Account

Please print this information sheet for your reference

Effective the 2021-2022 Season, e-Hockey no longer exists and there is a new version of the Hockey Canada Registry called HCR 3.0 Spordle where coaches can review their qualifications.

If you have not done so already, you will need to create an account for the new HCR 3.0 system and link your member profile. Please see the HCR 3.0 Spordle Account – Create & Link Members document for instructions on how to do this.


To View Qualifications and CRC (PIC)

1. Visit the Hockey Canada Registry 3.0 Spordle website and login to your HCR 3.0 Spordle Account.





2. Your dashboard will appear showing your linked Members. **IMPORTANT:** As the account holder, you must see two profiles for yourself on this page — one with a "crown" as the account holder and one with your name, HCR ID, date of birth and the linked relationship "self". If you do not have the second profile, you must link a member to connect your HCR ID to your account.






3. Click on "Members" on the left side panel. In the Members screen, click on the initials of Member you would like to look at. IMPORTANT: If this is your account and you are looking for your profile details, you will click on the second set of your initials (the first set is the account holder profile which lists limited information and will not have your qualifications).




- 4. Click on "Qualifications" below member name to view all Coach Qualifications.
 - This will bring you a list of all Coach Qualifications including Respect in Sport-Activity Leader,
 Coach HU courses and Coach Certification Clinics/Instructional Stream Clinics. The
 qualifications in "white" background are valid and the ones in "blue" background are
 expired. Please note the validity period on the last line of each qualification.






5. Click on "CRC" below member name to view Criminal Record Check on the profile. This is also referred to as the Police Information Check.



A VSC is a Vulnerable Sector Search which is required. Please note the Expires On column – it
must be AFTER the end of the current season (ie. for 2021-2022 season, the expiry date should
show 2022-05-31 or later).
